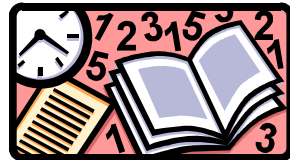
Semi-annual membership meetings are held in February and in September. Members are asked to attend these meetings if at all possible.
